Regional Convention

At the end of each July, delegates from all the clubs meet for a few days to discuss issues of mutual concern, and also to elect officers and members of its board of directors for the coming year. 2017 turned out to be a year of decision on many levels, where delegates discussed streamlining some of the older procedural rules and candidates with fresh ideas clashed with those happy with the status quo. In the end, Gary Mussell from the Southern California Naturist Association, was elected President. Cyndi Faber from Arizona's Shangri-La club won Vice President. A new secretary was also elected, Danielle Smith (als from Shangri-La), and Russell Lucia was re-elected Treasurer.

Elected for the first time as directors were Ernie Weise from Mountain Air Ranch, Colorado) and Jeff Tendick (Shangrila). Re-elected to the board of directors were Mike Glinzak from Olive Dell Ranch, California, and Andy Walden from the Hangin' Loose club in Hawaii. They join five other directors who were not up for election this year (they will be up for election in 2018). Together, the nine-person board makes policy, established priorities, and manages the budget for the various regional programs.

We will spend a little time each month discussing what the board is doing on behalf of its members.

Each board member gets assigned 2-3 clubs in the region to be its personal liaison to the board-as-a-whole. Your assigned liaison will be in contact with each club during the next month to hear any special problems you may have, and to listen to your suggestions.
