Started in 1976 as National Nude Weekend by the Nudist Society's founder Lee Baxandall, this annual celebration of social nudity has evolved into a week-long celebration by all the nudist organizations around the globe.

The second week in July is set aside by all the AANR clubs for special events. Many clubs provide discounted gate fees that welcome new guests trying social nudity for the first time (check your local club for any special rates).

For example, Saturday, July 14 is International Skinny Dip Day being celebrated worldwide.

Delegate Credentials Packets Being Sent to All Clubs

AANR-West has mailed credentials packets to all club presidents confirming their participation in the summer convention, August 2-5.

All clubs and Associate (members not affiliated with a club) are eligible to participate and vote at this annual meeting where your ideas and suggestions for improving our service and operations get discussed and voted on. Each Associate (not affiliated with any club) in attendance gets one vote, and clubs get delegates based on a formula of one vote per 25 members.

Clubs need to mail back a signed form listing the names of who their delegates and alternates to the convention will be. Also included in the packet will be nomination forms should anyone wish to run for a seat on the Board of Directors for AANR-West. There are five open seats this year. Please consider giving some us some volunteer time this next year!

Also in the packet will be forms to nominate any worthy Man of the Year, Woman of the Year, and Family of the Year. We prefer these awards be given to the unsung heroes in the clubs who work very hard and deserve some recognition.


Have You Made Your Reservations Yet for the AANR-West 2018 Convention?

Announcing the New AANR-West Nudist Club Passport Program

Our new Nudist Passport Program will commence August 3, 2016. At the summer convention. Here is how it works:



- The Nudist Passport is designed to encourage visits at multiple nudist resorts and parks throughout the Western United States. There are 29 AANR clubs in the region.

- Simply bring your passport with you when you check in at the club's front office. They will have a stamp to mark their page in the passport book. They will sign and date your visit. That's it!

- Visit a minimum of at least 6 resorts and/or travel clubs in a 12-month period.
- Mail us your completed passport by November 15, 2019 to the address on the back page of this booklet to be eligible for the prize drawing.
- Purchase a new passport. Passport books cost \$5 each (to cover production costs). They can be purchased at any participating nudist park or club in the region.

Participation in this program is entirely voluntary.

Farewell to Gigi Kraus

January 31, 1931 □ June 1, 2018

Gigi and her husband Horst Kraus emigrated from Germany in the 1960's and fell in love with Shangri-La Ranch in Arizona as a vacation destination. When the club went up for sale in 1996, the couple bought it and turned it from a rundown 50-site RV park into the desert oasis it is today with over 160 RV sites accommodating full time residents, RV travelers, and those looking at getting away for a weekend or simply a relaxing day.



The club hosted many AANR West festivals, and meetings over the years and Horst and Gigi received many awards including the Hal O'Neill award and the Glen Eden award. Horst and Gigi were inducted into the AANR-West Hall of Fame in August 2017.

Gigi suffered a brain aneurysm in December of 2012 from which she never fully recovered. Gigi passed in her sleep on June 1, 2018.

She leaves behind her husband of 65 years, Horst and 3 daughters, Patty Faber, who is an AANR Trustee and soon to be AANR Vice President; Elvira of New River AZ and Autumn Kraus-Hill of Irvine, Texas, and 5 grandchildren include Danielle Smith, the AANR-West Secretary and Cyndi Faber, AANR-West Vice President, and 4 great-grandchildren.

Auburn Dam, Sacramento River

The California State Parks Department and the US Bureau of Reclamation are collaborating on a new General Plan/Resource Management Plan for Auburn State Recreation Area, located on the north fork of the American River. Just below the Auburn Dam, is a very popular destination for nudists in this part of California.

A public workshop was held on December 7, 2017 in Auburn. AANR-West and GAT were well represented by **Tim Mullins** and other members of the nearby **Northern Exposure club**. Tim reported that nobody objected to the nude beach area as the focus of concern seemed to be access to the area by pet dogs (currently banned) and a demand to build bicycle trails in the park.

Another public hearing is scheduled for June 26 and Tim and his team will be attending. We will report back next month on what happened.

Little Nudity Legislation This Year

Election years are usually when we see a flood of anti-nudity bills introduced by local politicians wanting to use our way of life as a campaign issue. This year, however, it has been extremely rare to see any such bills in the eight western states of our region. One such bill in Hawaii never got a hearing.

Neither has there been many anti-sexting bills or proposals to restrict the use of hobby drones over private property or public parks or beaches (our position is nobody should have their image photographed or videotaped while nude without personal approval).

It seems the politicians are too preoccupied with guns, walls and kids in detention camps to worry about the people who want to hang out together without clothes.

World Naked Bike Ride is Coming to Los Angeles June 23

AANR-West, NAC, and several local nudist clubs are co-sponsoring the 11th Annual World Naked Bike Ride through the city of Los Angeles on Saturday, June 23.

Those interested can RSVP on Facebook at: www.facebook.com/WNBRLA. Directions will be posted on this page the night before the ride. The first leg of the ride will start at approximately 11-11:30 AM.



The ride is open to anyone who wants to support the event as an expression promoting bike safety, alternative transportation and positive body-awareness. Clothing is always optional during the ride.

You ride “as bare as you dare.” Many will choose to be, body painted or costumed in some form.

The second leg is about 13 miles long and will take about 3 hours to complete. That segment takes the riders along the LA river, up through Silver Lake, down Sunset Blvd, past Chinatown and Dodger Stadium, and LA City Hall. A police escort is being provided.

Don't forget to bring several bottles of water, sunscreen, sun glasses, a hat, and optionally a towel to sit on the bike seat. Cameras are also allowed but be polite and ask permission before taking someone's picture.

Nude Laser Tag Games Are a Hit with So Cal Clubs

Sunday morning May 27, Naturists in the OC rented out Lazer Legacy in Yucaipa before their regular business hours to enjoy a few games of Lazer Tag without clothes! There were 35 players from various clubs, separated into teams, wearing special vests and shoes (and nothing else).

Nudism in Mexican is Becoming Very Popular

On June 3, 2018, the Mexican Federation of Nudism (<http://federacionnudistademexico.org/>) held a general assembly in Mexico City to elect a new executive team for the federation.

Affiliated with the INF, this federation was founded in 2011, and has been growing with affiliated groups all over the nation. In his report, the out-going president, Juan Castañeda, mentioned the legal designation of the long-time naturist beach of Zipolite in the southern state of Oaxaca in 2016, and the three very successful consecutive nudist festivals celebrated there each February since 2016

The General Assembly chose between two highly qualified and enthusiastic teams led by the presidential candidates Mercedes Ruvalcaba (La Fuerza del Nudismo) and Hector Martinez of the Nude and Natural Guadalajara (NNG) club. Martinez, age 27, won by majority vote.



Martinez is also an AANR member and we are working to get NNG to become an affiliated club for the region.

The assembly also voted for AANR-West and FNM member Claudia Kellersch to be the official delegate to the next INF World Congress held in Portugal in October 2018, giving Mexico representation for the first time at the INF level.

AANR West president Gary Mussell has extended an invitation to Martinez, as the new president of the Mexican federation, to attend the AANR West Convention at De Anza Springs in early August and speak at a workshop about the rapid growth and acceptance of nude recreation in Mexico.

If you are planning to attend the convention, this workshop should definitely be something not to miss. Get your questions on nudism in Mexico answered and find out about upcoming organized, low budget English-language trips to various parts of Mexico! Discounts of 10 percent for AANR members are already available and will be extended in the future.
