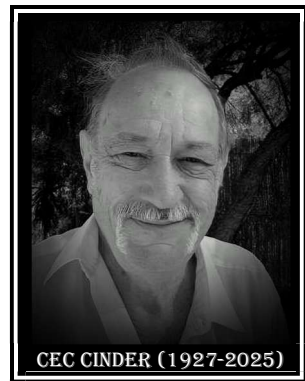

**Internal Administration** – The committee has nothing to report to the Regional Assembly.

**Finance** – The committee has nothing to report to the Regional Assembly.

**Public Relations** – Each subcommittee reports individually:

- **Tourism Outreach** – The subcommittee has nothing to report to the Regional Assembly.
- **Social Media** – Gary Holden stands by his report as written:
  - Though reaching his term limit as a director, Gary will continue chairing the PR committee.
  - The region's X account is gaining eight followers daily on average; BlueSky is also gaining popularity.
- **Website** – Tom Stark stands by his report as written:
  - Traffic to *aanrWest.org* is up every year.
  - There has been a small surge in hits from Australia, the UK, and Germany in recent months.
- **Blogs** – The subcommittee has nothing to report to the Regional Assembly.
- **Newsletter** – Gary Holden stands by his report as written:
  - There are no new developments to report regarding *The Western Sun* at present.

**Membership** – Cyndi Tendick presents a verbal report:

- A review of the End-of-April club membership counts is discussed.
- The BUFF-A-TEERS club based in Tucson has relinquished its charter due in part to low membership.
- On a positive note, GLEN EDEN SUN CLUB has gained 44 new members.
- AANR continues to look at clubs that are unresponsive to inquiries, no or outdated websites, &c.

**Club Relations** – Jeff Jackson stands by his report as written:

- The non-landed club chats began as a monthly conversation but may switch to bi-monthly or quarterly.
- Thank you to Larry Gould for explaining the nuances of 501(c)(3), 501(c)(7) and LLC status.
- **California** – Mark Pavelchak stands by his report as written:
  - **GLEN EDEN SUN CLUB** – Water volleyball now has a new pool by the Butterfly Pavillion. The matches are open to all skill levels, and everyone is invited to join the fun.
- **Colorado** – Jeff Jackson stands by his report as written:
  - **ROCKY MOUNTAIN NATURIST CLUB** – Membership in *Colorado Young Naturists* is growing, especially after their recent EDM<sup>1</sup> pool party and have requested lanes be reserved at the next nude bowling night.

- **Hawai'i** – Andy Walden stands by his report as written:
  - **HAWAIIAN NATURIST PARK** – The property is under new ownership which has brought new capital for proposed expansion. Activity at Halema'uma'u is bringing lots of visitors to the Big Island of Hawai'i.
  - **SWIM FREE HAWAII** – Capt. Chuck schedules one trip daily. He is licensed, insured and equipped for up to six passengers. Explore coral reefs and tropical fish — nude!
  - **Zoning Issues in Hawai'i County** – Short-term vacation rentals require registration and adherence to certain regulations. The county council is actively working on stronger regulations for short-term rentals.
- **Utah** – Andy Walden stands by the report as written:
  - **SOUTHERN UTAH NATURIST SOCIETY** – Temperatures are reaching over 100°, so the pool is the place to be. Membership has grown and attendance has now doubled in size.
  - **WASATCH NATURISTS** – No recent information is available to report to the Regional Assembly.

**Marketing** – The committee has nothing to report to the Regional Assembly.

- **Brand Awareness** – Andy Walden reviews the report from Joe Klingman as written:
  - Nude recreation may be on the brink of revival with a 742% increase in online searches for nudist campgrounds and clubs in 2024 compared to the previous year.
  - Clubs age without reinventing themselves, and newcomers often find themselves in environments that feel more like retirement communities.
  - The solution is to reintroduce Nudism's values through a modern lens. Talk less about nudity and more about what it feels like: freedom, body positivity, nature connection, family togetherness, and digital detox.
- **Multinational Outreach** – Andy Walden stands by his report as written:  
The genesis of this subcommittee was to develop awareness about Nudism *south of the border*. With the data regarding an increase in website traffic from Europe and Australia, the focus will shift for the new term.

**Women in Nude Recreation** – The committee has nothing to report to the Regional Assembly.

**Family** – Mark Pavelchak presents a verbal report:

There are a lot of young families visiting GLEN EDEN SUN CLUB this summer, so the resort is planning special kids' activities throughout the season. A recent Saturday included a *slip- 'n' -slide* and refreshments.

**Young Adults** – The committee has nothing to report to the Regional Assembly.

**Sports** – Mike Selby stands by the report as written:

- The committee sent out a survey but had little luck finding the correct format that was easily accessible. Expanding outreach to the Northwest Region might yield more feedback during the new term.
- Sports has been an integral part of all clubs, and we know there are thriving sports programs out there. We need two surveys, a landed and non-landed one, to capture as much data as possible.

**Bylaws & Procedure Manual** – Larry Gould stands by the report as written:

Appreciation to Kathy Watzel, Suzanne Schell and the committee for their insight into preparing this year's motions to update the Regional Bylaws regarding voting procedures.

- **BL Art IV, § C, sub-§ 2** – The additional verbiage approved in 2023 somehow got reverted to the previous wording when the July 2024 edition was published and the glitch was never caught until recently.

We move that... the Bylaws, Art. IV, be amended as follows:		
<p>E. All amendments to the governing documents shall be posted on the AANR-West website no more than ten (10) days after the close of the call for agenda items, as announced by the Secretary, to be placed on the Official Regional Assembly meeting.</p> <p>1. Motions coming from an AANR-West committee shall be considered as duly seconded.</p> <p>2. All other motions shall require a second before being posted on the AANR-West website.</p> <p>3. All motions shall be broken into their individual parts.</p> <p>4. Once posted on the AANR-West website, an email shall be sent to all members assigned to AANR-West by AANR noticing the posting of the amendments.</p> <p>5. Any member of AANR-West may provide feedback on motions during the period of posting up to the actual vote. This may be done on the website portal or in person at the Regional Assembly.</p> <p>6. Only accredited delegates in attendance during the Regional Assembly, either in the meeting room or via video-conferencing, shall then be allowed to vote on the amendments.</p> <p>a) The rationale for the requirement to be present during discussion of amendments concerns potential changes to the amendments during the discussion period for each amendment.</p> <p>b) Nothing herein prevents the discussion of potential amendments in global context; however, each amendment shall be voted on separately and the vote recorded by the Secretary of AANR-West.</p> <p>c) It shall be the province of the Board and only the Board to determine whether or not a compound motion is being made.</p>

**Government Affairs Team** – Steven Schubert stands by the reports as written:

- **AANR Gov’t Affairs** – Tim Mullins presents a verbal report:
  - Multiple bills have been introduced during this session aiming to enhance penalties for certain sexual activities, frequently incorporating the term *nudity* within their provisions.
  - The annual NCSL conference is crucial to AANR’s ability to connect with state and regional legislators to inform, educate and help them understand nude recreation, so that “broad-brushed” laws are defeated.
  - Also being watched is a new crop of bills based on *thought, words or deed* in the use of AI to generate nude images of people, especially of minors, whether or not they depict an actual or artificially created person.
  - AANR aims to prevent nudity regulations from impacting all nude recreation, not just seeking exemptions for itself. As a family organization, we already maintain our own standards of conduct.
- **AANR West GAT** – Steve Schubert reviews the regional affairs:
  - A thank-you to Richard Dewey for keeping watch on regional developments during Steve’s absence.
  - Over 70 bills at any given time may need review across the region’s eight states. Volunteers are needed and welcome to help track bills in your local area!
  - Special interest groups often draft bills and then seek lawmakers in various districts to sponsor them. Similar language will be found in bills from different districts.
  - *State Net* is a legislative and regulatory tracking and intelligence service that helps navigate the constantly evolving landscape of state and federal laws and regulations.

- An artifact from Cec’s archives shows that GLEN EDEN SUN CLUB has been an active participant in the Region from the start. The medallion is from the 1964 WSA Fall Festival, hosted when the club was barely a year old! Much of his collection is now at the Library.





**Fredericka Carlile** – A heartfelt thank-you to the Board of Directors for the time serving with its members. The help and support in forming the GOLDEN VALLEY SUN CLUB a little over a year ago. Allen and Freddie began with a small group, but soon people across Kingman and Bullhead City started asking about their barbecues, swimming parties, and holiday events. 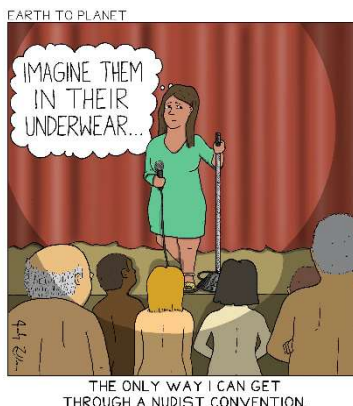
